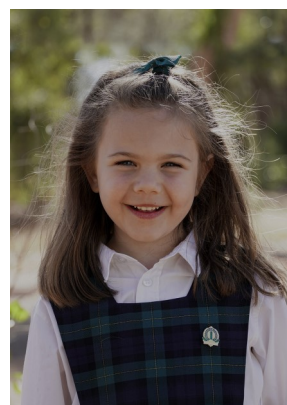

To Whom It May Concern

The popular Cattle Junior Judging & Parader's Competition will be going ahead again at the Lake Cargelligo Show this year and will be held on Saturday, 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2019.

These competitions are really aimed at the novice level of competitors to try and generate more interest in the cattle industry and feel that what better way to do this than via a casual and friendly competition at the Lake Show.

The Overjudge, Mr Denis Moxey, will hold a Parader's and Judging Workshop at 10am at the Lake Cargelligo Showground in the area beside the cattle yards prior to the competition beginning at 11am. There will be three levels in both competitions ie Novice (for absolute beginners despite the competitor's age), Intermediate (for those competitors who have participated in any previous competitions) and Open (for those competitors who really know what they are doing and may have placed in any previous competition).

The Parader's Workshop, which is judged solely on the person, will teach competitors about the characteristics that the Judge is looking for such as the presentation of themselves, the presentation of the animal including how it is paraded and the amount of contact the competitor has with the judge are all taken into consideration.

The Junior Judging Workshop will explain certain aspects of the body of an animal and why one particular beast might be better than another. Competitors then have to place animals in a particular order of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> and then need to convince the Judge why you placed them in that order. This is a great way to learn about what constitutes a good animal and creates confidence in public speaking.

If your school would like to bring along some of your cattle, you are more than welcome and ask that you let us know as soon as possible if this is the case.

Anyone over 8 years old is eligible to participate and is FREE to enter. Elders Lake Cargelligo will again be sponsoring this event with many prizes up for grabs for placing's in both competitions. Whilst this invitation is extended to schools, the competitions are also open to local and individual competitors as well.

Looking forward to your support in this Competition and ask that you please confirm your attendance and student participation by 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 if possible.
