SFX have invited us to join them for the Funky Books show, a highly interactive presentation, designed to promote a love of reading through humour, fun and engagement.

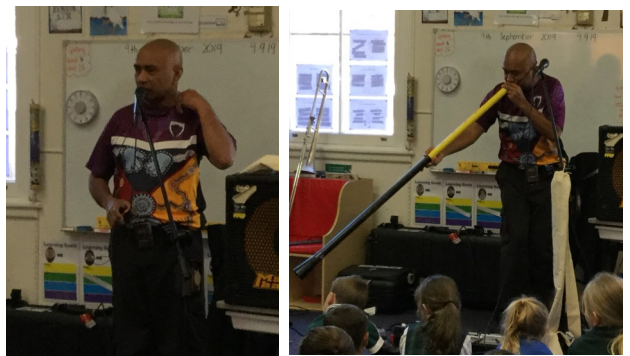
