- 1 wholemeal pita, sliced in half
- ¼ cup hummus or Babaganoush
- ¼ cup grated carrot
- 1 handful baby spinach

For extra interest try also adding one of these:

- ¼ cup no added salt canned chickpeas, drained & rinsed
- 2 tbsp feta cheese, crumbled
- 3 sun-dried tomatoes, sliced



3 Kalamata olives, halved

Method

Spread the dip inside each pita pocket. Place the rest of the ingredients in the pocket.
