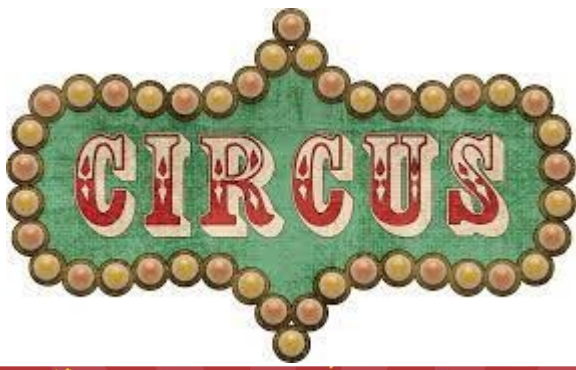

Clubgrants Category 3 fund re-invests profits from registered club's gaming machines into community projects. Funding is available for infrastructure projects in four (4) keys areas; Arts & Culture, Community Infrastructure, Disaster Readiness, and Sport & Recreation.



A total of \$12.5 million is available to the NSW Community this year. Not-for-profit organisations, Schools and Local Councils are eligible to apply for grants of between \$10,000 to \$200,000.

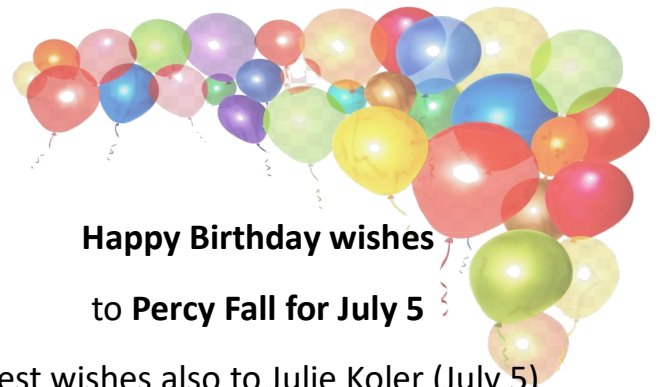

MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID Australia

BLENDed ONLINE AMHFA COMMUNITY COURSE

Learn skills to support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples experiencing a mental health problem or mental health crisis in a culturally capable way.

The Blended Online AMHFA Community Course has been adapted from the Standard MHFA course for people 18 years and over who may be providing MHFA support to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People. This course has been developed to support information about providing mental health first aid, and undertaking self-care being provided into Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

Become an Accredited Mental Health First Aider
Demonstrate your mental health first aid skills by becoming an Accredited Mental Health First Aider. Complete an online assessment after the course to become accredited.

Why attend an MHFA course?
Research has found the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander MHFA course to be effective and culturally appropriate, empowering Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People and providing information that is highly relevant in assisting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People experiencing mental health problems.

What is the format?
Blended Online Mental Health First Aid Courses are an alternate delivery pathway for the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Mental Health First Aid Course. Blended Online MHFA courses include 2 components:
Course Component 1: 7- hour self-paced eLearning component
Course Component 2: 5- hour Instructor-led component using video conferencing.
