



Applications for the NSW Government's <u>Clubgrants</u> <u>Category 3 Infrastructure Grants</u> are now open with local organisations across the Cootamundra Electorate encouraged to apply.

Clubgrants Category 3 fund re-invests profits from

registered club's gaming machines into community projects. Funding is available for infrastructure projects in four (4) keys areas; Arts & Culture, Community Infrastructure, Disaster Readiness, and Sport & Recreation.



A total of \$12.5

million is available to the NSW Community this year. Not-for-profit organisations, Schools and Local Councils are eligible to apply for grants of between \$10,000 to \$200,000.






