PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Students were kept busy last week completing end-of-year assessments. It's always one of my favourite times of the year as we reflect on where students were at the beginning of the year and measure their growth over two semesters. One of the most exciting set of results was Spelling. This year we tried a new program designed to develop reading, writing and spelling skills through phonemic awareness. On average, our students achieved a growth of one and a half years in their spelling age in a nine month period. Staff will now begin to write student reports over the next few weeks.

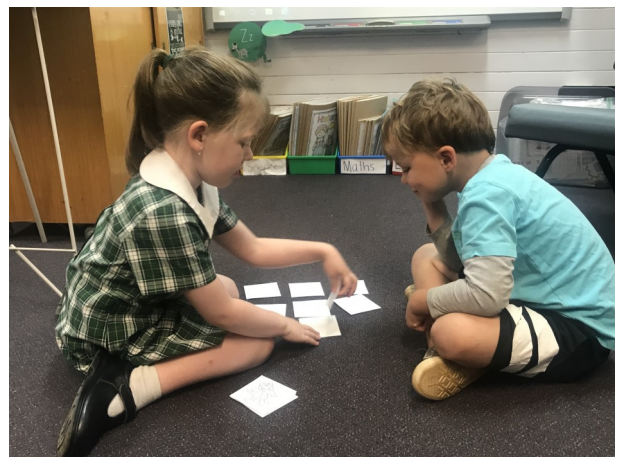
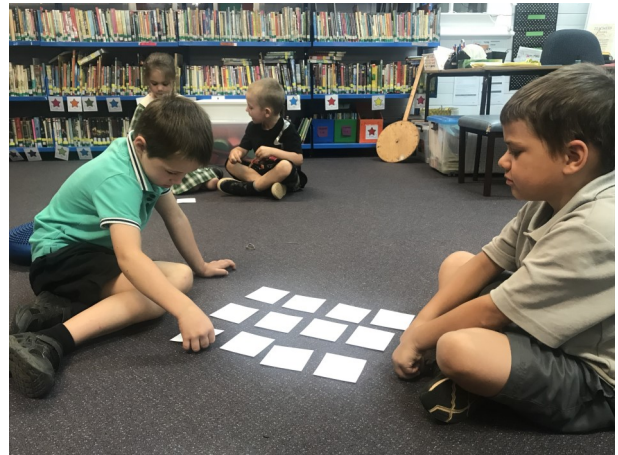

This semester we have been receiving our school counselling service through telecare and an outreach program provided by Royal Far West. I attended our final RIEN meeting for the year, continuing the work with Jenni Wall, Curriculum Advisor on Thursday. We started working on a Scope and Sequence for the new PDHPE syllabus and discussed how our small schools can work collaboratively on programming in 2019.

On Friday, Ella, Lily, Kaleb and I participated in the White Ribbon March in Lake Cargelligo, saying no to violence. We heard from the White Ribbon ambassador who had a very powerful message to share about domestic violence.

The last day of term for students will be Wednesday 19th December. The school will be hosting a Christmas lunch for students, families and school community members. Invitations will be sent out soon.

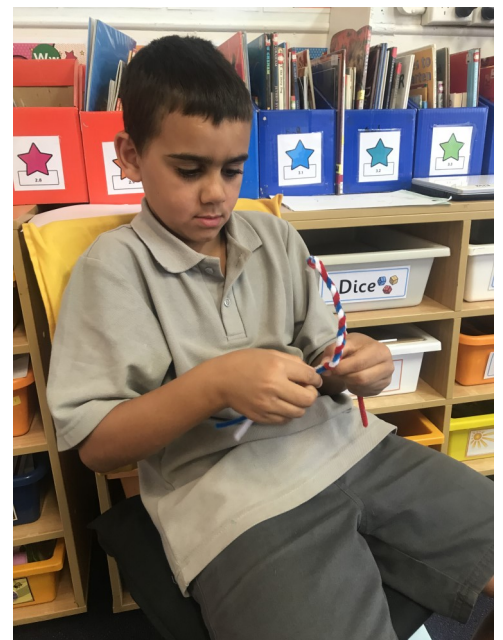
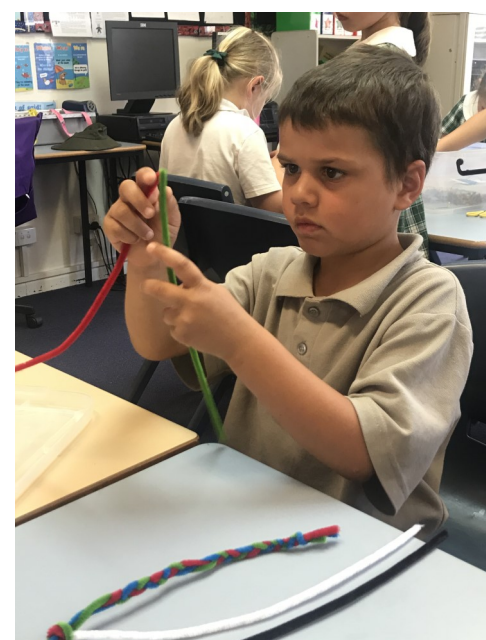
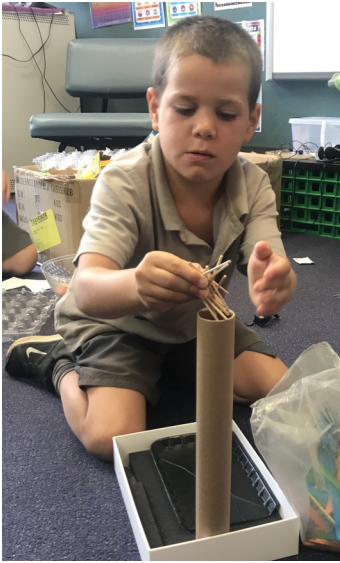
